Enclosed is information concerning the Carmel Summer School Program. Included is a list of *tentative* course offerings, the Summer School registration form, and information regarding the Summer School Policy.

PROGRAM: All courses will be on a repeat basis; only students who have failed a course will be allowed to register to take a course.

REGISTRATION: Classroom seats will be limited and will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Students must have a completed application form signed by an Administrator, along with the required registration fees. Students will register with Mrs. Bottema in Room 145. The last day to register for Summer School is Thursday, July 5, 2018.

COST: Registration is \$10.00 per class. Fees are payable to Mrs. Bottema in Room 145. Checks should be made payable to Carmel Summer School.

DATES: Our summer school program will begin Monday, July 9, 2018 and continue through Wednesday, August 15, 2018. Classes will be held Monday through Thursday. The last day of classes will be Wednesday, August 15, 2018.

LOCATION: Classes will be held at Carmel High School. Students should enter and exit through the Bridge entrance only and are not permitted to be in any other part of the school without their teacher or permission from their teacher or administration.

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2018 CARMEL SUMMER SCHOOL POLICY

The parent or guardian of the registered student and the student must sign and submit this basic list of rules and regulations by July 5, 2018. The CCSD Code of Conduct is enforced at all times during summer school.

**STUDENTS ARE AT NO TIME ALLOWED TO LEAVE CAMPUS
UNLESS THEY ARE LEAVING FOR THE DAY.**

ATTENDANCE: Since the summer program attempts to compress 180 sessions into just twenty-three (23) two-hour periods attendance is a high priority. There are no excused absences (legal or unexcused illegal), **JUST ABSENCES. THIS RULE CONTINUES THROUGH THE FINAL DAY OF CLASSES.** No student will be permitted to take an early or late final examination.

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY: Carmel Summer School enforces the Zero Tolerance Policy. Any student involved in a drug or alcohol incident during the summer school day will be immediately expelled from the summer school program and will be referred to the Sheriff's Department.

CONDUCT: Students are required to conduct themselves in a manner appropriate to an academic setting. Behavior that is inappropriate will result in expulsion from summer school. Cell phones, beepers, radios, tape players, headsets, MP3 players, iPods, CD players and Playstation portables are prohibited from use in summer school.

ATTIRE: Students are expected to wear school attire that is appropriate and non-distracting. Strapless, backless and any see-through clothing is prohibited. In addition, any clothing displaying obscene or objectionable messages and clothing bearing references to drugs, alcohol and tobacco is prohibited. A student may be sent home if the attire is deemed to be inappropriate or distracting and the student will be considered absent in this case.

SMOKING: Any student found smoking on school grounds will result in their permanent suspension from summer school; this policy includes e-cigarettes. New York State law prohibits any use of tobacco, including chewing tobacco and e-cigarettes on school grounds.

Only students, staff and others authorized by the school administration may be on school grounds during summer school hours.
