2019 Junior Prom and Post Prom Information Packet

Included below is a series of informational items to help make our 2019 Junior Prom and Post Prom a continued success. Please read carefully.

As stated in the previous mailing and posting on the CHS website, the Junior Prom is on April 26, 2019 at Anthony's Pier 9 in New Windsor, NY, from 5:30pm -10:30pm.

Once again, Carmel High School, in conjunction with the District Administration, has decided to use charter buses for transportation to and from the prom. ***All students attending the Junior Prom will be required to take the charter buses to and from the prom site. Only students riding the charter buses will be allowed into the prom.***

The buses will pick up and drop off students at George Fischer Middle School. Students should arrive at George Fischer Middle School no later than **4:00pm and check in**. Buses will depart from George Fischer Middle School promptly at 4:30pm and return to George Fischer Middle School at approximately 11:30pm for students to go home and change before Post Prom. Students changing at friends' houses should make the necessary arrangements with respect to clothes and luggage beforehand in order to reduce the number of bags brought on the buses. The buses will then be making a second stop at the High School for all those who need to change at the high school for the Post Prom. Post Prom festivities at Carmel High School will begin at 11:30pm. Please be advised, all bags are subject to search.

*There are several other events occurring at GFMS in the afternoon and evening of April 26. Please allow additional time for drop-off. We ask that parents and guardians remain in their vehicles during drop-off and not use this as an opportunity to take pictures or to see students depart on the bus. **Please see the included map for drop-off, parking, and no parking or standing locations. Long-term parking at GFMS may be extremely limited due to the number of events taking place and therefor is highly discouraged.***

School Attendance Student attendance is mandatory for periods 1-3 on Friday, April 26. Students who provide a note to leave after period 3 will be marked absent with parent permission.

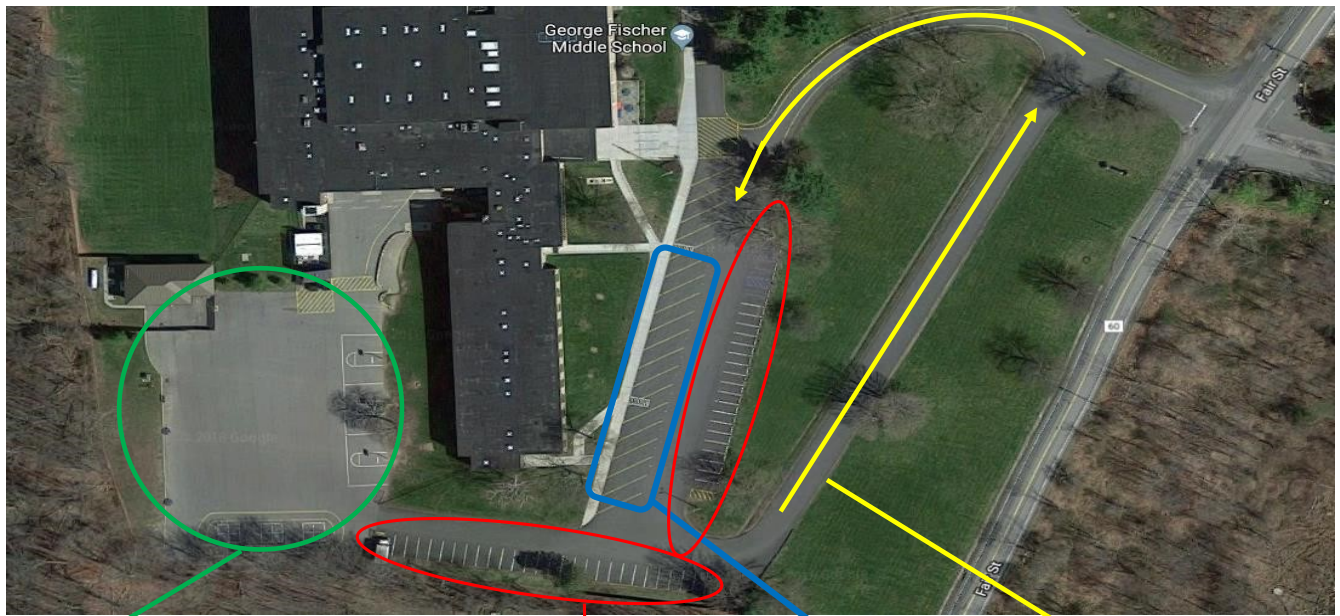
Early Dismissal To leave early (after period three), students must submit a signed note from a parent to any assistant principals' secretary. The student will receive an Early Dismissal Prom Pass that they will need in order to exit the building on Friday, April 26. Early Dismissal Prom Passes are available beginning Tuesday, April 23 through Thursday, April 25. Students without this pass may not leave unless a parent comes in to sign them out.

Student IDs Please be sure that all students attending Prom and Post Prom have their student IDs with them.

Depart Check-in no later than 4:00pm at GFMS and report to your assigned bus for 4:30pm (sharp) departure. Bus assignments will be posted in CHS a few days prior to prom.

Arrive Approximately 5:30pm at Anthony's Pier 9.

- Return** Leave 10:30pm from Anthony's Pier 9 and arrive at approximately 11:30pm at GFMS.
- Post-Prom** Post Prom will be from 11:30am – 3:00pm at Carmel High School.
- Post-Prom Guests** All Juniors may attend Post-Prom. Only guests who attended the prom at Anthony's Pier 9 may attend Post-Prom.
- Inclement Weather** In the event of inclement weather on the day of prom, please check your Email, Twitter, and the high school website home page regarding the bus departure.
- Code of Conduct** We expect all Carmel students and their guests to adhere to the Carmel High School Code of Conduct.
