Application for "Upstreet Privilege" 2019/2020

Dear Parents:

As you are aware, Juniors, Seniors, and students of the Alternative High School are offered the privilege of leaving campus during specified times of the school day (9:30am - 1:50pm) if they exhibit the appropriate responsibility and are in good academic standing.

Stipulations for an "Upstreet Privilege":

- 1. You must be a Junior, Senior, or Alternative High School student in good academic standing. (Any student who has failed two or more classes or was denied credit on the June report card is not eligible.)
2. When students do leave campus they are to move directly to their destination without stopping in front of the building or in front of nearby establishments. STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO USE CARS WHEN OFF CAMPUS DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.
3. Students are not to congregate in front of the building before the school day or during their free time. Students are to come directly in the building when they arrive at the beginning of the school day.
4. Students must have their student identification card on their possession when leaving the building and it must be worn while upstreet. If you forget your card, you may not leave the campus on that day. Loss of your student identification card requires a \$5.00 replacement fee.
5. Any student who does not abide by the stipulations above will lose their "Upstreet Privilege."
