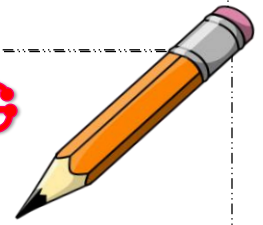
READING

S.O.L.V.E.

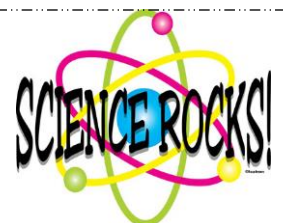
- ♥ Students will continue to identify the components of the S.O.L.V.E. strategy.
