READING

- * We are using Non-Fiction Text Features to gather information from the Non-Fiction texts that we read.
- * We are using context clues to determine or clarify the meaning of words in Non-Fiction Texts.
- * We are determining the main idea and details within the Non-Fiction texts we read.
- * We are asking and answering questions about key details in Non-Fiction Texts.



WRITING



- * We are working in groups to gather information about Non-Fiction Topics.
- * We are writing individual reports about the animal topic we researched, which includes relevant information about our topic and Non-Fiction Text Features.
- * We are developing opinions about our topics and using factual information from Non-Fiction Texts to support our opinions.
- * We are enhancing our writing by writing interesting facts that include adjectives and verbs.
Example: The zebra eats grass. The black and white striped zebra grazes on tall green grass.

MATH

- * We are adding within 20 using different strategies such as Adding by Counting on From 10 using a Picture or Ten Frame.
- * We are using a Place Value Chart to show numbers to 20 as tens and ones.
- * We are using Place Value Charts to compare numbers by figuring out how much greater or how much less.
- * We are ordering numbers by making number patterns.

SOCIAL STUDIES

- * We will learn how families grow and change over time.
- * We will create a time line to show how we grow and change.
- * We will learn about family life long ago and today.

SCIENCE

- * We will learn how living things have offspring that are the same kind as them.
- * We will learn how offspring may look different from their parents even though they have the same structures.
- * We will learn how offspring defend themselves when they are grown.
- * We will learn how offspring survive in the same way as their parents by using structures that are the same as their parents' structures.
- * We will learn that some kinds of young offspring get help from their parents and other kinds of offspring survive on their own.
