### **After School Enrichment Program February 20 – March 14, 2019**

Dear Parents:

Once again, the Delaware Township School Partners in Education (DTS PiE), along with the Delaware Township Board of Education, is offering after-school enrichment classes this winter. **The program will run on Wednesday and Thursday for four weeks, beginning on February 20<sup>th</sup> and ending on March 14<sup>th</sup>** except as noted for specific courses.

The Enrichment program costs about \$6,000 to run, is open to all students at DTS, and serves approximately 200 students each spring. In an effort to offset costs, we are suggesting a donation of **\$25 per child**; if they do more than one class, please consider donating a little more to offset costs. If you have already paid the Program Fee for this 2018-19, no payment is necessary but any additional contributions you are able to provide is appreciated. We welcome all children regardless of ability to pay. If your child(ren) want(s) to participate, and you are not in a position to donate, please register anyway.

Children are expected to follow the behavior standards that are required during the regular school day. Classes begin immediately after school and end at 4:15 p.m. Dismissal will be at the middle school exit. Per school rules, any child in 4th grade and younger must be signed out by a parent or guardian. Additionally, please make sure to send a note **daily** indicating your child will be staying after school for each day of Enrichment.

This program is run by volunteers and cannot continue without your help. Parent volunteers are needed to assist the instructors, babysit volunteers' younger children, and to help with logistics. If your child/children will be participating in the program, please consider volunteering. The attached form includes a description of each course and a registration form for both class selection and volunteer sign up. Please note that all classes are limited in size and to specific age groups.

If your child would like to participate on both days of the Enrichment program, you may enter class choices for each day. However, you must mark which day is your child's first choice at the top of the registration form. We will make every attempt to fill all first choices and then fill in with second choices where space is available.

**To register, return the form to your child's teacher marked "Enrichment Program" as soon as possible, but no later than, Friday, February 1st.** Late registrations may be denied class placement. Your child will receive a note, through their DTS teacher, confirming their placement the week of February 11<sup>th</sup>. Parent volunteers will also be contacted at that time.
