Dear Parents of 8th Grade Students

HCRHS counselors will be meeting with the 8th grade on February 13th for a student assembly to explain the scheduling process and some of the important items they will need to understand as they begin their careers as students at Hunterdon Central. Their course recommendation forms will be mailed home prior to that day. I will be meeting with your students individually should they require my assistance selecting their electives or have any questions. Their teachers have already recommended them for their core classes. Please use this as your work sheet as you discuss which classes you will be scheduling for freshman year.

A Q&A at the high school will take place on February 20th @ 6:30pm and you are invited to attend. They will be posting informational videos on their website about scheduling and we will be receiving these videos and posting them on our website for your convenience. I recommend if you have never had a child attend Hunterdon Central that you and your child view the videos together before scheduling and prior to attending the Q&A.

On-line scheduling takes place the week of February 22nd through February 26th. You should receive your child's login information along with explicit directions. If you do not receive it by February 20th, please contact me immediately as you will not be able to schedule without a login.

The pink copy MUST be returned to me once scheduling is completed otherwise I will not be able to guarantee you will get the appropriate elective alternatives for your child. The deadline is March 1, 2019; no pink copies will be accepted after this date.

Any correspondence I receive from the high school will be posted to our website. Please check the website periodically for these updates.
