With the next few months of Wyoming weather being unpredictable, buses may be arriving a few minutes late before or after school. Thanks for your patience as you are waiting for your child's bus to and from school.

Thank you for the continued support in promoting positive behavior on all of the buses. We need your help by reviewing the following guidelines with your child.

- Follow the directions of the bus driver.
- Stay in your seats; no walking or standing in the aisles when the bus is moving. The driver's job is to keep you safe.
- Use inside, not outside voices.
- Be five minutes early and ready for your bus to arrive. Parents please supervise this area.
- Look for any lost gloves, hats, scarfs and any misplaced items in the lost and found in the school. Bus drivers will turn in any found items to the school office weekly.
- Earn Northmart Bucks for showing positive behavior. Good behavior and high expectations don't end when students load the bus, it continues while riding the bus home.

Thank you for not parking in the bus lane when dropping students off in the morning. We need to keep the area in front of the school clear for district buses. We continue to have cars parked in areas not marked near the front of the school.

Students need to bring proper winter clothing to school every day. Students do go out to recess unless the wind chill is below zero. Please be sure your child has a winter weight coat, hat, gloves, and boots. They should also bring regular shoes to change into.
