Math

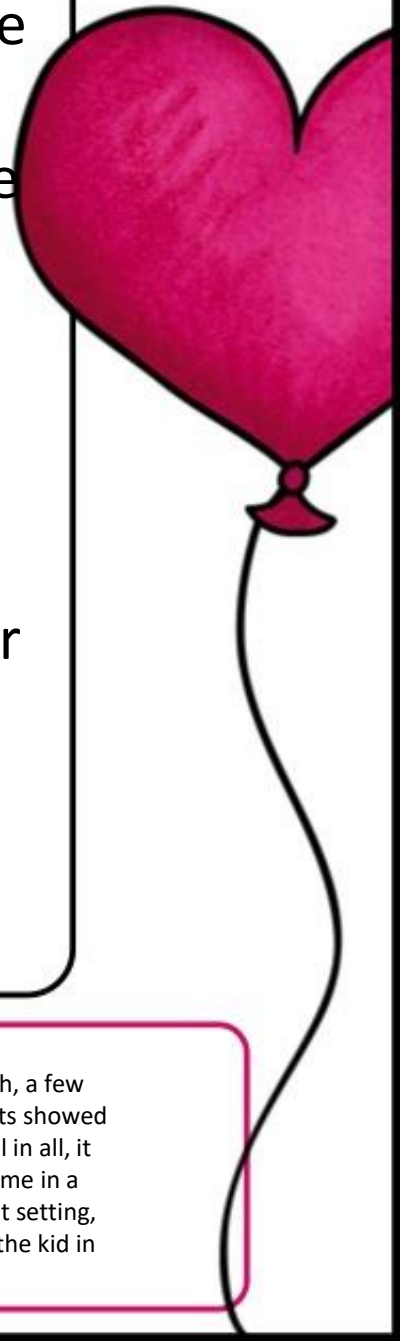
