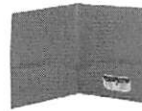
Please send your child to school with the following supplies for First Grade.

DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE



When in the course of human events, it becomes necessary for one people to dissolve the political bands which have connected them with another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a decent respect to the opinions of mankind requires that they should declare the causes which impel them to the separation.

We the Representatives of the United States of America, in General Congress assembled, do hereby declare that these United States are, and of right ought to be, free and independent States; that they are absolved from all allegiance to the British Crown, and that all political connections with Great Britain are hereby totally dissolved.

In witness whereof, we have hereunto set our hands and seals, this fourth day of July, in the second year of the Independence of the said United States.

Done at the City of Philadelphia, in the said States, the fifth day of September, in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty-three.
