Dear PS 203 Kindergarten – Fifth Grade Families,

I'm writing to let you know about the new Breakfast in the Classroom (BIC) program coming to PS203.

Beginning on March 12, 2018, our school will participate in this innovative program that is already in place in most schools in NYC and other major cities across the country. BIC breakfasts are free! BIC was introduced to NYCDOE elementary schools in an effort to alleviate hunger and ensure that all students are ready to learn each day. This program plays an essential role in the healthy cognitive, social and emotional development of elementary school children.

PS 203 has selected the BIC "grab and go – hybrid" delivery option from among the available BIC delivery options.

- Our school will continue to open at 7:40 AM and children entering from 7:40 AM-8:05 AM may take a "grab and go" breakfast to eat in the cafeteria.
 - 1st grade – 5th grade children arriving after 8:05 AM will take a "grab and go" breakfast to their line up locations, hold onto the breakfast and eat in the classroom.
 - Grab and go breakfasts will be delivered directly to kindergarten rooms for Kindergarten students who come in at 8:10.
- Children will have approximately 10-15 minutes to eat in their classrooms.
 - Please note that ONLY BIC "grab and go" breakfast food may be eaten in the classroom.
