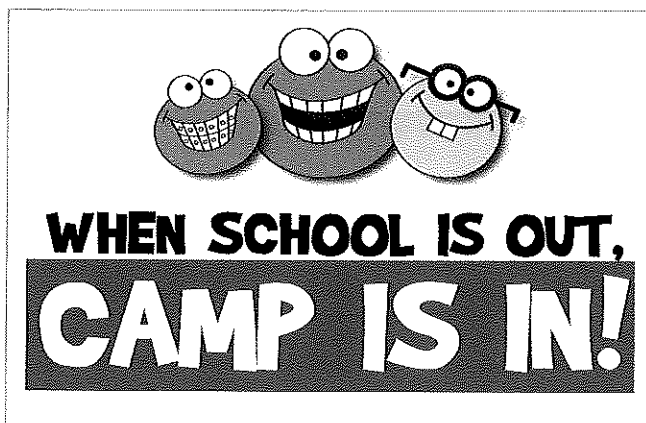

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW!

Traditional Camp

- The summer camp (traditional camp) is open to children who are 3 years old (*and totally potty trained – NO EXCEPTIONS*) to 12 years old.
- Traditional campers will enjoy crafts, games, activities, movies – *and one field trip each week – onsite or off site!*
- Snacks are provided for the morning and afternoon. Campers must bring lunch and drink each day.
- All campers will attend Vacation Bible School at Blessed Sacrament Church (June 25-29 from 9:00 a.m.-12:00 noon). Camp fee includes cost of VBS.
- **NO DROP INS!**

Specialty Camps

- *Specialty camps are available for an additional fee that should be paid to the instructor at enrollment in that camp. The instructor of the specialty camp will acknowledge the payment and enrollment.*
- Specialty camp times are 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.
- Half-day camp (12:00-6:00 p.m.) is available if attending a specialty camp that week. Half-day camp fee is \$95.

How to Register

- Camp fee is \$170/week for the 1st child and \$110/week for each additional sibling.
- *Early Bird (6:30-7:30 a.m.) is available. The cost is \$5 a day for your child to attend Early Bird.
- Checks should be made payable to BSCS. *Credit cards are not accepted.* Please ask for a receipt if paying in cash.
- First full week's payment is due when registration is turned in to hold your spot as the deposit.
- Payments are due on the Wednesday before the next week's camp.
- If camper is not a BSCS student in 2018-2019, a copy of the DHEC immunization certificate is required.

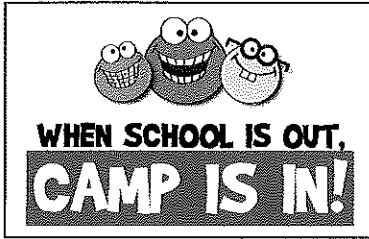

"Staff" includes camp and BSCS staff.

Please indicate your authorization by initialing on the appropriate lines.

_____ I agree to pay the weekly camp fees. The weekly fees are due on the Wednesday before the following camp week. I understand that failure to pay may result in my child not being allowed to continue in camp and that I will be billed for the unpaid balance and possibly what is due based on what was indicated on the Intended Attendance form.

_____ I agree to sign my child in upon arrival and sign for my child at pick-up, realizing that no camper should arrive or leave unaccompanied by an adult.

_____ If picking up for the first time and if someone other than a parent comes for your child, proof of identification will be needed.

_____ I understand that I will be contacted should someone "not on the list" come for my child. No child will be dismissed from camp without permission.

_____ I give permission for my child to be transported by a hired bus service on field trips.

_____ If an activity includes swimming, my child has permission to participate in swimming activities. *Please assess your child's swimming abilities.*

_____ Non-swimmer (no instruction)

_____ Beginner swimmer (limited instruction)

_____ Intermediate swimmer (average swimming ability)

_____ Advanced swimmer (skilled swimmer)

_____ I give the staff permission to apply sunscreen and/or bug repellent (provided by the camp) on my child as needed.

_____ Should my child become ill at camp, I will be notified as soon as possible. If I cannot be reached, the emergency contact on the registration form will be called. If the staff feels that my child should not stay at camp, someone will come for him/her immediately. The camp does not have "sick room" facilities.

_____ In an emergency, I authorize the staff to take the necessary actions required for my child's well-being. The actions may include calling a physician, calling EMS, or transporting my child to a medical facility. I will rely on the judgement of the staff to determine if EMS is needed - even if it is before I or the emergency contact is called. I agree to be financially responsible for any action deemed necessary by BSCS.

_____ I agree to come for my child should I be called because of significant misbehavior (as determined by the staff).
