- 4 containers of disinfectant wipes (Lysol preferred)

SINCE bSCS is a school and not a daycare, we have different regulations than a daycare does. Per ass guidelines, Children will need to:

- * use the Potty appropriately

- * Pull Clothing back on (We recommend elastic waist Clothing, belts are not recommended unless your Child knows how to use them)
- * Change their Clothes if they have a accident

We are not allowed to:

- * Wipe/Clean Children
- * 90 in the bathroom with the Child
- * Change Clothing

We understand accidents will happen as your child is getting used to the schedule the first weeks of school. We will do our best to coach and encourage your child. If your child is unable to adequately clean themselves, you will be called to come change your child. (however, if your child is consistently having accidents past the first two months, you will be asked to take a break at home to firm up potty training. We will hold your spot for you.
