Use a variety of materials to add to your work - be imaginative!

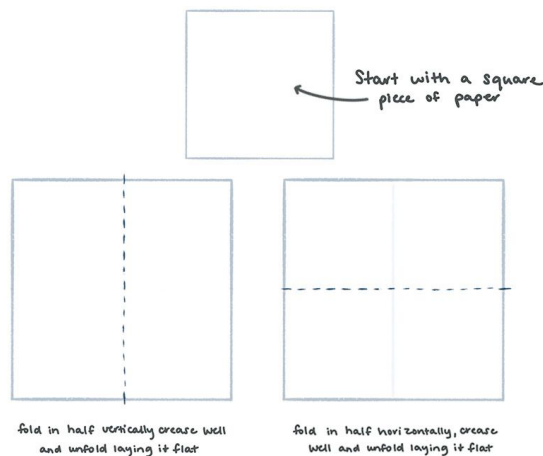

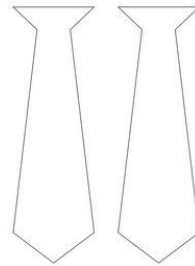

b. Tool Design - on vertical fold. Choose one of the tool shapes shown (or your own) to draw on front of the card.



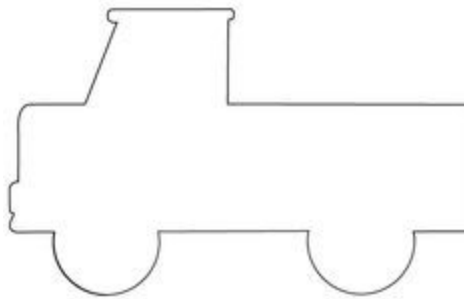
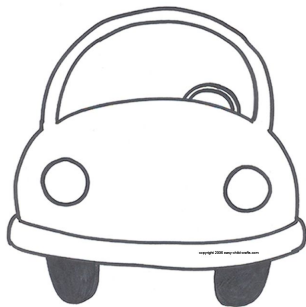
Decorate using a mixture of colors, designs and materials. Include "Happy Father's Day" .
