The regular meeting was held on Monday, March 11, 2019 in the school library.

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 P.M. by Chairman Doug Cahill. There were no additions or amendments to the agenda.

Motion by B. Kenny/2nd by D. Rathbun to give approval for the three children to attend Sharon Center School next year. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

The Assistant Superintendent and Superintendent reviewed their written reports, highlighting those items they especially wanted to bring to the attention of the Board Members.

March 28 is "All Boards Day" at Sharon Center School, with the BOE and other Sharon boards invited to take a tour of the school.

March 26 is a Board Retreat @ 5:30 in room 133 at HVRHS.

On April 8, there will be a meeting at HVRHS from 9:00 – 11:00 A.M. to review Educational Legislation.

The board reviewed the 2019-2020 Spending Plan.

Motion by B. Kenny/2nd by D. Rathbun to send this Spending Plan on to the Board of Finance tomorrow for their approval. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

After discussion,

Motion by B. Kenny/2nd by A. Vance to keep the Non-Resident Tuition Rate at the current rate of \$9,000 per student for the 2019-2020 school year. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
