Bylaws of the Board

Officers

Officers of the Board of Education

The Board's officers shall consist of a Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and a Secretary.

Election of Officers

The October meeting of the Board of Education in an election year will be the organization meeting. Election of officers will be the first order of business at this meeting. In years when a town election is held, this Board election must take place within thirty days of the town election.

Moderator of Election of Officers

The Superintendent of the Regional District or a designated agent will serve as Moderator for the Board's election of officers. The new officers will take office immediately upon completion of all the elections.

Nominations

Nominations for office will be made from the floor by Board members and each nomination will require a second.

Election

Election ^{may} shall be by paper ballot and will require a majority of the total membership of the Board. No more than six successive ballots will be allowed for the chairmanship before a tie or a failure to elect will be declared. A majority of those present and voting will determine whether a special meeting will be held to carry out the election of officers or whether the matter will be referred to the Board of Selectman under Sec. 10-218.

Removal from Office

Upon motion duly made and seconded, an officer of the Board may be removed from office by a majority of the total Board membership voting by paper ballot.
