There will be a Board of Ed Meeting this Monday, June 10th at 6 PM.



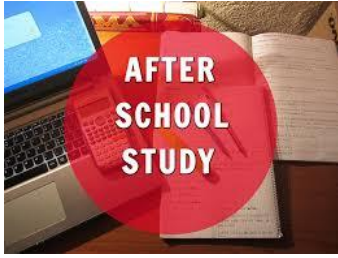
Field Day will be held on Tuesday, June 11th (rain date of June 12).
