The American Legion Legacy Scholarship

Those eligible to apply for the scholarship shall be the child/children or legally adopted child/children or a child of a spouse by a prior marriage or dependent child as defined by the United States Armed Services of active duty United States military and National Guard, and military reservists who were federalized and die on active duty on or after September 11, 2001. The applicant must be a high school senior or high school graduate to apply for the scholarship. Scholarship is for undergraduate study at an accredited institution of higher education within the United States. Application must be post marked no later than **April 20, 2019**. INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING FOR THE SHIRLEY WILLIAMS WALKER ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

1. To be considered, a complete application packet **MUST** be submitted by **April 19, 2019**.
2. Omission of any part of the application will eliminate the application from consideration.
3. Applicant must be planning to become an **education major** and currently have a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative Grade Point Average on a 4.0 scale. Applicant must be actively involved in extracurricular activities and verifiable community service.
4. Parent/Guardian of applicant must sign Disbursement of Scholarship Funds Agreement.
5. Academic scholarships will be awarded upon verification of enrollment from your college. Verification entails an enrollment form completed by the institution with the Registrar's signature and official seal of the institution or a copy of Fall schedule. Scholarship checks will be made payable to the college/university. Please see Mrs. Bailey for a copy of the application.

Reminders:

**All males between the age of 18 and 25 need to register with Selective Services at www.sss.gov before completing the FAFSA application.

**Make sure you are up to date on college applications. You should apply NOW if you have not already done so. Check with Admissions Offices for Open House Dates.

**Check with the college's financial aid office to make sure you have completed all required paperwork and ask about additional scholarships. See your high school guidance counselor if you have any questions.

**If you need transcripts sent to a college or to a scholarship organization, please remember to supply envelopes and postage.

**Any senior athlete who plans to play a sport in college should register with NCAA. The website for registration is www.eligibilitycenter.org . There is a registration fee. If you have previously used a fee waiver for the SAT or ACT you may be eligible for a waiver for NCAA. See your counselor for more information.

**If you receive a letter informing you that you are a scholarship or award winner, please bring the letter to guidance. We must have written verification in order for you to be recognized at Honor's Night.
