Dear Parents and Guardians,

Upson-Lee High School will provide face-to-face students the opportunity to complete missing classroom assignments, assessments, and progress in Edgenuity courses each Saturday from 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM. To participate, the student should notify their teacher(s) in advance of attending Saturday school to allow the teacher the opportunity to collect and provide the necessary assignments to the Saturday school instructor. We also offer a credit recovery program for at-risk students after-school every Monday, Tuesday, & Thursday from 3:15 PM – 5:30 PM. The credit recovery program provides a small-group environment for students to receive academic assistance from a certified educator.

Due to the closure of school and shift to distance learning at the end of the 2019-2020 academic school year, we are providing these opportunities free of charge to those students who failed a course in the Spring 2020 semester. If a student wishes to participate in after-school credit recovery, the student will need to register via their school counselor. We will be providing notification of their eligibility via a parent letter and School Reach. Students who are recovering an academic credit, due to a course failure in Spring 2020, will have until December 11, 2020, to successfully complete the course.

Students that need to recover credit, excluding courses failed Spring 2020, are responsible for the standard fee, \$35 per course. These students are afforded the opportunity to complete the Edgenuity courses at home. Although courses can be completed at home, these students are able to attend after-school or Saturday school as needed. Additional program information is provided below.

Registration Process for Upson-Lee High School Credit Recovery Program

Upson-Lee High School face-to-face students enrolled for the 2020-2021 academic school year can attend the after-school program to recover academic credits and progress in their Edgenuity courses. Upson-Lee Learning Academy students can attend the after-school program. Face-to-face students are eligible to recover credit for a 1st 9 weeks or 2nd 9 weeks course for grades lower than a 70.

Registration Process for Upson-Lee High School Credit Recovery Program (COVID-19)

Upson-Lee High School face-to-face students enrolled for the 2020-2021 academic school year can participate in the after-school credit recovery program at no-cost to recover credit for courses not successfully completed in Spring 2020. Students eligible for the after-school credit recovery will be notified by their school counselor. Remote learning students will have the opportunity to participate in the credit recovery program remotely and cannot attend the in-person after-school option.
