At Home

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CES parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in reading and math. Families may have others ideas to add to this list:

- Check Dojo daily for class information and behavior
- Read newsletters and find ways to use helpful hints at home
- Spend time with students to practice letter/sound/word cards as well as any other home learning assignments
- Attend a PTC meetings, or student activities, parent meetings, or nine weeks awards ceremonies in order to stay informed and involved
