<u>Early Dismissal Days</u> – December 1 and December 22 are planned early dismissal days. Please make arrangements for changes in pick-up prior to those dates if necessary.

<u>Change in pick-up</u>: Please make every effort to inform us of changes in pick-up as early as possible. We prefer that you send a note in with your child to the classroom teacher in the morning. It is difficult to change our dismissal lists to specific staff in the late afternoon once they have been distributed.

Emergency Drill- During November, we will have a Lockdown drill. December's emergency drill will be a fire evacuation.

Attendance - Please remember the following for tracking attendance:

- a.) All late arrivals and early dismissals without formal documentation are considered unexcused.
- b.) An absence becomes excused when the school receives formal documentation within ten days of the absence.
- c.) A student is considered truant if he/she accumulates 4 unexcused absences in a month or 10 unexcused absences in a year. A student is considered chronically absent when he/she misses 20% of their school attendance for any reason.


