NEWS FROM TITLE 1 - 4th and 5th grade Title 1 Reading Intervention have been reading about the wild horse issue on the Navajo Nation. Four viewpoints have been heard and the 5th grade students got to meet with some of the people involved. Leland Grass, co-founder of Dine' for Wild Horses came to speak with the students and answer their questions. Later this month they will communicate via Skype with Simone Netherlands from the Salt River Wild Horse Project. The students will be using their best writing to create a proposal of their own to send to the Navajo Fish and Wildlife Department, the Bureau of Land Management, and the Navajo Agriculture Department. Both the 4th and 5th grade students are working hard and pushing themselves to do their best reading and writing work to complete this proposal.

Each newsletter will focus on a different group and the work they are doing in Title 1 Intervention.


Many of you already know me as I have taught 4th grade for three years here in Crownpoint. This year, I have transitioned to teaching **ART**
