

Accessing Google Meet from Home

Google Meet is an app designed by Google to help you video chat using your Chromebook. It is like Facetime, Zoom, or Skype. You will use this app to meet online with your teachers during their office hours.

Once you are logged into your computer, you need to open Chrome.



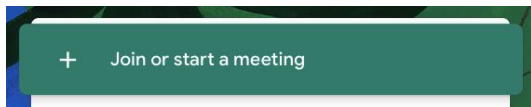
Then you want to look for your “candy bar” in the upper right-hand corner of the Chrome window.



Open the candy bar and look at all of your apps. Look for the app called “Meet”.



When you click on Meet, you will see a button that allows you to “Join A Meeting”.



Your teacher will have a name for your meeting and will email you the name that you will type into the block. You may also receive an email asking you to join the meeting.

Enter the meeting code or nickname. To start your own meeting, enter a nickname or leave blank.

Continue

Click on the green Continue button once you have typed in the meeting name. It does have to be spelled correctly.

Your computer will give you the message “Getting Ready” and then you should see yourself on your screen through the Chromebook’s camera.

Click the green “Join Now” button and you will be a part of the Google Meet.

Join now
