



6. The Superintendent has the authority to waive a particular clearance if a physical condition or disability inhibits one's ability to obtain a usable fingerprint reading.
7. Permission to utilize a volunteer may be revoked at any time by the Superintendent.
8. The head coach, advisor, or teacher in charge will assume daily responsibility for the actions and training of a volunteer.
9. A volunteer may not direct or supervise a school-sponsored program, a group of students, or an individual student belonging to any such program outside the immediate supervision of a professional staff member during the school day. A head coach/advisor and/or assistant coach/advisor or teacher or building administrator shall be present during all training, practices, and/or other events of said school-sponsored program(s).
10. A volunteer may direct or supervise a school-sponsored program, a group of students, or an individual student belonging to any such program outside the immediate supervision of a professional staff member after school hours as long as they have clearances and parent permission of the students.
