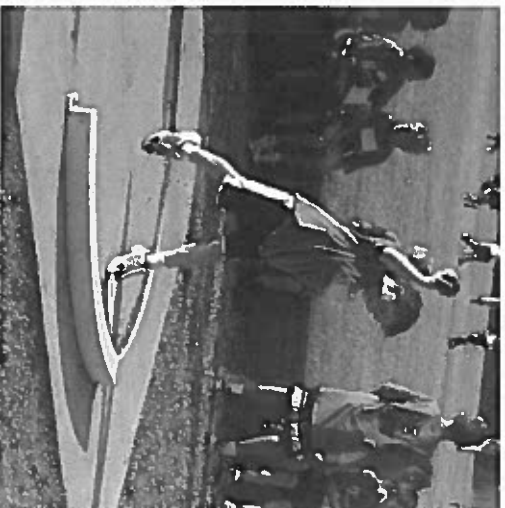
The Summer Twilight Series will be held at Suffern Middle School beginning on June 19th at 6:00 pm. Events include Jumping, Throwing and Running.
