As you know, the safety and well-being of our students is our top priority. We are hard at work to ensure that our students can continue to learn from home. **Dr. McCahill has announced that schools are closed Monday, March 16th through Wednesday, March 18th.** During this time “At Home” learning will begin, Monday, March 16th is Day 1.

Our teams of teachers have designed “at home” work for students. **Below you will find a link to grade level documents outlining work for each day of the closing.** You will notice that the information is organized much like the schedule of a normal school day.

Como saben, la seguridad y el bienestar de nuestros estudiantes es nuestra principal prioridad.
