Water stations will be provided near the outdoor portions of the games, to refill water bottles when necessary.

Donations will be acknowledged that day.

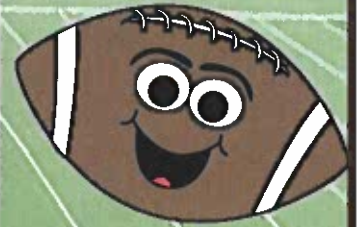
