During the “H Games,” third and fourth graders will take part in a series of challenging athletic events requiring teamwork, critical thinking and problem solving. Both grades will participate, with their entire class, in a fun-filled day that culminates this year’s physical education program. The “H Games” are intended to be a chance to participate in challenging events, both indoors and outside, and reflect on the skills and teamwork that have been taught all year long.

The 4th grade will participate in the morning session, beginning at 9:30 am and ending at 11:15 am. The 3rd grade will participate in the afternoon session beginning at 12:35 pm and ending at 2:20 pm.

Please be sure to check the weather report as it can be extremely hot or un-seasonably cool in May. **We are requesting that all students bring some type of water bottle clearly labeled with their name.** We would like to reduce the trash created by using cups. Water stations will be provided near the outdoor portions of the games to refill water bottles when necessary.

Dear Incoming Fifth Grade Parents/Guardians,

Middle School students in all grade levels are required to wear uniforms for physical education class. 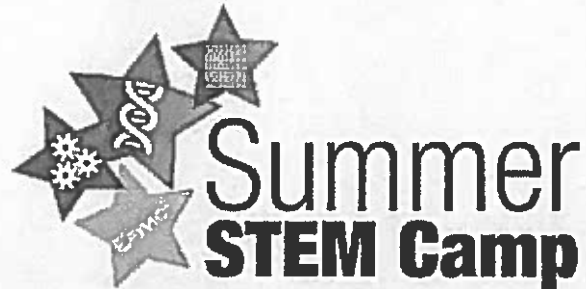

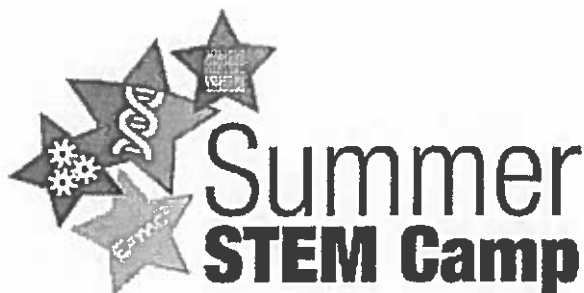
