

Selection Procedures for NHS

Any junior or senior who has a 3.75 cumulative GPA may print an application and apply in September.

WHAT happens after I turn in my submission packet?

A faculty committee reviews each candidate's submission materials. Students are rated (points given) in four of the five categories:

- a. Scholarship – This is determined by the GPA & used only in inviting students to apply-this is not a scoring component.
- b. Character – This is determined by teacher recommendations. You may not be selected based on discipline record.
- c. Leadership – This is determined by the completed application reviewed by the faculty committee.
- d. Service – This is determined from the completed application reviewed by the faculty committee.

Non-selected students have the opportunity to appeal to the principal within five days of non-selection. After five days, they forfeit the right to appeal. The principal's decision is final. The national NHS organization does not hear appeals.
