

Reporting Suspicious Persons or Activities Directly to Law Enforcement

The below information has been provided by the Louisiana State Police on how the public can report information about suspicious persons or activities directly to law enforcement. Any information about suspicious persons or activities affecting LPSD schools or sites should be immediately reported to that school's SRO / local law enforcement, administration, staff, and supervisors.

Historically, a majority of thwarted terror attacks have been the result of someone reporting something suspicious and can also be important if a school attack is being planned. An important aspect of prevention is to involve the public in a Suspicious Activity Reporting system. In Louisiana Suspicious Activity Reports may be submitted by going on line to <http://dpsweb.dps.louisiana.gov/suspicious.nsf/WebForm?OpenForm> or calling the 24 hour line at 1-800-434-8007. Suspicious activity may also be reported via smartphone. The free app offers users the ability to write or take a picture of anything that seems suspicious.
