# NEW REQUIREMENTS

**All Students

- Algebra I and Geometry or Integrated Math I and II
- Physical Science
- American History and American Government
- English I and English II

**And Meet  
One of the  
following  
three:**

- Cumulative passing score on End of Course Exams.
- Earn “remediation-free” score on either ACT or SAT.
- Earn a State Board of Education- approved, industry-recognized credential or a state issued license for practice in a career and achieve a score that demonstrates workforce readiness and employability on a skills assessment.

# **7 END OF COURSE (EOC) EXAM PATHWAY**

## **Freshman Year:**

English 101, Physical Science, Algebra I

## **Sophomore Year:**

English 102, Geometry, US History

## **Junior Year:**

Government

**Students can earn from 1-5 points for each exam,  
based on their performance.**

- 5 – Advanced**
- 4 – Accelerated**
- 3 – Proficient**
- 2 – Basic**
- 1 – Limited**

# **GRADUATION POINTS**

**With few exceptions, students must accumulate a minimum of 18 points from scores on their end of course exams to become eligible for a diploma.**

- **English: 4 points (between 2 exams)**
- **Math: 4 points (between 2 exams)**
- **Science and Social Studies: 6 points total (between 3 exams)**

# **EOC CONT.**

- **Students who take physical science, American history or American government as part of Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate or college dual credit programs can use their scores from the programs' end-of-course exams in place of the state end-of-course exam scores to accumulate graduation points.**
- **A student who earned high school credit in any of the above courses before July 1, 2014, automatically will receive a score of three points per course exam toward the total points needed for graduation.**

# **“REMEDICATION FREE” PATHWAY (ACT/SAT OPTION)**

## **Current set scores:**

- **ACT ►** English 18      **SAT ►** English 440  
                  Reading 21                      Reading 450  
                  Math 22                                Math 520
- **The state of Ohio will pay for all 11th-grade students in the Class of 2018 and beyond to take the exam free of charge.**

# WORK FORCE READINESS PATH

- Student must earn a state Board of Education approved, industry-recognized credential or a state-issued license for practice in a career and achieve a score that demonstrates workforce readiness and employability on a job skills assessment.
- State Board of Education has yet to establish a score, or which programs and licensures meet qualifications. (This will affect 2018 Freshman their Junior and Senior years.)
- Administration of the career assessment does not exempt the school district from administering the end of course exams to those students.
