➤ Grades PreK-12 School-wide Title I Programs

Title I is the largest Federal Aid Program for Elementary, Middle, and High Schools. Through Title I, the Federal Government gives money to school districts nation-wide based on the number of low income families in each district, each district uses its money for extra educational services for children most in need of improvement in the standards-based skills of Reading and/or Math.

Parent Right-To Know* Information

In accordance with the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, Section 1111 (h) (6) "Parents' Right to Know," this is notification from the School City of East Chicago to every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right to request and receive information in a timely manner regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teachers,

Information shall include the following:

- If the teacher has met the state qualifications and licensing criteria for the grade level and subject areas taught
- If the teacher is teaching under emergency or temporary status in which Indiana qualifications and licensing criteria are waived
- The teacher's baccalaureate degree major, graduate certification, and field of discipline
- Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications
- If at any time your child has been taught four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher that is not highly qualified, you will be notified by the school of this information, in addition, we are enclosing a copy of the SCEC Family Involvement Policy with this brochure.

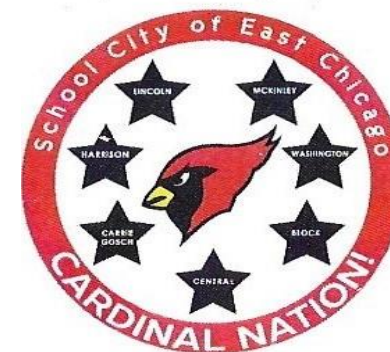
