

DRESS CODE AND PERSONAL APPEARANCE

All students are expected to come to school clean and neat.

HAIR FOR BOYS AND GIRLS

Hair is to be kept neat and clean at all times. No extreme colors (no orange, platinum, green, blue, purple, pink, etc.) or extreme hairstyles (ombre, fades, mohawks, etc) are allowed.

Boys' hair needs to have ears cut out, bangs must not cover the eyes, and must not be longer than the collars of their shirts.

Girls' must keep long bangs pulled off their faces and out of their eyes. Small barrettes, plastic headbands, etc. are the only accessories items for the girls. The accessories must be hunter green, yellow, white, or the school plaid. They must be plastic or cloth. No flowers or additional adornments may be on the accessories.

JEWELRY FOR BOYS AND GIRLS

Students may wear a watch (no Smart watches are allowed), ring, religious medal or symbol. GIRLS may wear post earrings, if they have pierced ears. No more than 2 earrings per ear be worn in the lower lobe. If a student has cartilage piercing a spacer must be worn during school hours.

Students may wear one rubber wristband or hairband. No other bracelets are permitted. No inappropriate sayings may be displayed. No other jewelry is appropriate. Boys may not have pierced earrings. Visible body piercing jewelry and tattoos of any kind are not permitted.

NO JEWELRY PERMITTED ON ASSIGNED GYM DAYS

MAKE-UP AND NAIL POLISH

Girls in grades K-7 and all boys may not wear make-up at any time.

Girls in the Middle School (Grades 6-8) may wear light pink or clear nail polish. Girls in Grade 8 may wear black or brown mascara. No eye liner, blush, or foundation (liquid or powder) will be permitted. School personnel will ask the girls to remove nail polish and inappropriate make-up.

Girls in Middle School (gr. 6-8) may wear fake nails for special occasions. A note must be sent in to the homeroom teacher and signed by the Principal **before** the nails are applied. Students who do not have permission will have to remove the nails within 24 hours. Students who have received prior permission may wear the nails for one week.

CLOTHING

Leg warmers and boots may be worn to and from school during the cold weather but must be removed during the school day.

Shirts and blouses are to be tucked in at all times. Skirts may not be rolled. Skirts and jumpers are to be no shorter than 1" above the top of the knee.

All undergarments must be such that they do not disrupt the learning environment. This is at the discretion of the school.

All clothing must be clean, pressed, and not torn. No clothing may have writing or signatures on them. Hats/caps are not permitted to be worn in school. No light-up sneakers are allowed at any time.

Dress code violations are handled through the demerit system.

Gym Days

All students (K-8) must wear the school gym uniform:

Year Round

Hunter green St. Anne School sweatpants* and sweatshirt*
Ash St. Anne School T-shirt* or a St. Anne School Marathon T-shirt
Sneakers
White or black socks

First day of school until October 31 and March first until the last day of school (Summer Uniform)

Students may wear the hunter green micromesh nylon St. Anne School shorts*
Sweatshirt and sweatpants are optional
No knee-hi length socks may be worn with shorts.

Girls' Regular School Uniforms Year Round

Grades K-4

School plaid drop waist jumper* or Navy girls slacks* or navy skort*
Yellow short or long sleeve polo shirt with St. Anne School logo*
Navy or yellow knee-hi socks, navy tights or white over the ankle socks with sneakers

Grade 5

School plaid drop waist jumper* or Navy girls slacks* or dark green wrap around kilt* or navy skort
Yellow short or long sleeve polo shirt with St. Anne School logo*
With the jumper – navy or hunter green knee-hi socks
OR
With th kilt – Hunter green or white tights or dark green knee-hi socks

Grade 6-8

Dark green wrap around kilt* or navy girls slacks* with brown or black belt
Yellow short or long sleeve polo shirt with St. Anne School logo*
Dark green knee-hi socks or white or dark green tights with solid brown Or black dress shoes

Girls' Regular School Uniform Optional Items for first day of school until October 31 and March 1 until the last day of school (Summer Uniform) for Grades K-8

Navy girls twill walking shorts (fingertip length) and brown or black belt with yellow short sleeve polo shirt with St. Anne logo* and white over the ankle socks and sneakers

Grades K-8 Girls may wear hunter green or yellow V-neck sweaters with St. Anne logo*

Girls may not wear sling-back, clogs, high heel, backless sandals, flip flops, moccasins, or platform shoes at any time, including Dress Down Days. Sperrys must be solid brown, black, or tan. The height of shoes may not exceed 1".

Boys Regular School Uniforms Year Round

Grades K- 8

Khaki/Tan pleated twill pants with brown or black belt (Grades K and 1 the belt is optional) Cargo pants are not allowed

Hunter green short or long sleeve pole shirt with St. Anne School logo*

Grade 6-8

Optional white oxford short or long sleeve with a tie

Grades K-5

Black, brown, khaki/tan or white **over the ankle socks** with sneakers

Grades 6-8

Black, brown, khaki/tan or white **over the ankle socks** with brown or black dress shoes. No moccasins or boots.

Boys' Regular School Uniform Optional Items for the first day of school until March 31 and March first until the last day of school (Summer Uniform) for Grades K-8

Khaki/tan twill walking shorts (fingertip length) and brown or black belt. No cargo shorts are allowed.

Hunter green short sleeve polo shirt with St. Anne School logo*

White over the ankle socks and sneakers

Grades K-8 Boys may wear hunter green cardigan or V-neck sweaters with St. Anne logo*

Uniform) for Grades K-8

Navy girls' twill walking shorts (fingertip length) and belt (black or brown) with yellow short sleeve polo shirt with St. Anne School logo* and white over the ankle socks and sneakers

Grades K-8 Girls may wear hunter green cardigans or yellow V-neck sweaters with St. Anne logo*.

Girls may not wear sling-back, clogs, high heels, backless sandals, flip-flops, moccasins or platform shoes at any time, including Dress Down Days. The height of shoes may not exceed 1". Sperrys must be solid black, brown or tan.

Boys' Regular School Uniforms Year Round

Grades K-8

Khaki/Tan pleated twill pants with brown or black belt (Grades K and 1 the belt is optional). Cargo pants are not allowed.

Hunter green short or long sleeve polo shirt with St. Anne School logo*

Grades 6-8

Optional white oxford short or long sleeve shirt with a tie

Grades K-5

Black, brown, khaki/tan, or white **over the ankle socks** with sneakers

Grades 6-8

Black, brown, khaki/tan, or white **over the ankle socks** with dress shoes (must be black or brown). No moccasins or boots.

Boys' Regular School Uniform Optional Items for Quarters 1 and 4 (Summer Uniform) for Grades K-8

Khaki/tan twill walking shorts (fingertip length) and brown or black belt. No cargo shorts are allowed.

Hunter green short sleeve polo shirt with St. Anne School logo*

White over the ankle socks and sneakers

Grades K-8 Boys may wear hunter green cardigan or V-neck sweaters with St. Anne logo*

DRESS DOWN DAYS

Clothing must be neat, clean, and modest. No rips, tears, or holes. Students are not required to wear a particular color (for example – red, green, black, or orange, etc.) unless otherwise specified.

Shirts MAY NOT display inappropriate logos, phrases, or images.

No camisoles, tank tops, or low cut necklines are permitted. Shirts must cover the midriff and cannot ride up to expose skin. Shorts may be worn during summer uniform time. (first day of school until October 31 and March 1 – last day of school) but must be fingertip length.

St. Anne Sweatpants or St. Anne gym shorts are the **only** pants allowed to be worn on Dress Down days. Jeggings, skinny jeans, and yoga pants may NOT be worn. No tight fitting clothing.

No flip flops, backless sandals, clogs, or heels over 1” may be worn.

All accessories (hair, jewelry, make-up) must meet the criteria in the St. Anne School Dress Code. No exceptions are made for Dress Down Days.

Students scheduled to have gym on a Dress Down day are permitted to wear their dress down attire for gym. Please wear sneakers.
