I would like to update you on the Safety measures being addressed at St. Anne School.

With your help, from the Marathon, we have funds to purchase items to enhance our Safety protocols already in place.

I am investigating various types of safety door closures. I am in discussions with the Bethlehem Fire Department about various options. I consulted with Bethlehem Fire Department and Catholic Mutual regarding the use of escape ladders. Both highly discourage the use of these ladders as they create an extreme safety hazard

for the students.

We have the door company coming to repair one door and to put a swipe card system on another. We are getting estimates on speakers for the parking lot and the playground on Hickory Street. This way announcements will be heard outside. We are also getting estimates on upgrading the fire panel and surveillance system used throughout the school.

Many updates take time and I want to make the correct purchases. Please know that I have not forgotten about the safety of our school and students. This is a number one priority for me.

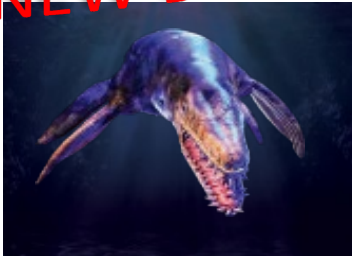

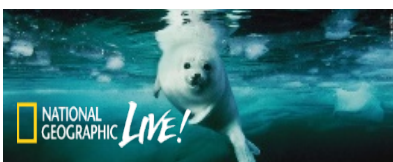
