3 large boxes of tissues

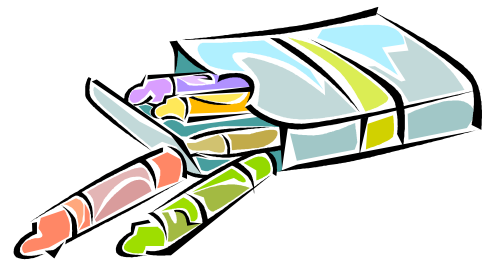
1 pack of 4 black dry-erase markers with erasers on the top

Dear First Grade Parents:

Many parents have asked us how they can help prepare their children for first grade. We agree that reinforcement during the summer months will help your child maintain the skills he/she develops in kindergarten. Below are some skills that you can reinforce with your child at home this summer.

**Your child should be able to:**

- Recite full name
- Write first name using lower case letters (Mary)
- Recognize all lower case letters, a through z
- Recognize numbers 1 through 10
- Draw or make sets of numbers (4 looks like \*\*\*\*)
- Name colors
- Know letter sounds

**In addition, it is important that your child be able to:**

- Tie shoelaces
- Zipper or button coat
- Put on boots
- Wash hands

Talking to your child and encouraging your child to answer in complete sentences is important for developing language skills. We also encourage reading with your child every day. Please encourage your child to continue to use **Dreambox Learning, Lexia** and **Raz-Kids** this summer.

Lastly, we are also asking that you do not purchase or send your child in with a book bag that has wheels. We have found this to be a hazard in our school. We look forward to seeing you all next year! Have a wonderful and safe summer!
