## Course Descriptions

**3-D Pop Art** - Students will learn how to make 3 dimensional shapes in cards and landscape art.

**Arts and crafts**- Each week unique crafts will be made by the students using recycled and traditional materials. **Material Fee:\$5.00**

**Beginner Spanish**- Conversational and some written language will be learned by students in a fun interactive environment.

**Bingo Club** - While fun, this club incorporates learning through Bingo. Students will have cards to identify farm animals, sight words, numbers, picture words, the alphabet (lower and upper case letters.)

**Board Games and Puzzles**- What do puzzles and board games have in common Teamwork and strategies of course! Students will learn both while having fun.

**CrossFit Aerobics** - Students will engage in varied crossfit whole body exercise with some aerobics dance moves.

**Dance** - Students will learn various techniques while creating movement and storytelling as individuals and as a group.

**Photography Class** - This club is designed to provide children with a creative environment to build useful skills they will use to create fun, unique photographic projects. **Material Fee: \$10.00 \* THIS IS A TWO DAY PROGRAM.**

**Dual Language Enrichment** - We assist and focus on homework completion as well as language development in both English and Spanish.

**Fun with Food** -Students will learn how to make basic kid friendly dishes each week. **Material Fee \$5.00**

**Games and Sports**- Appropriate games and sports will be introduced while also learning the importance of teamwork.

**Graphic Novels**-Students will begin with the basics of a graphic novel and then explore various genres as told in the graphic novel (comic strip form) style. **Material fee: \$10.00**

**Homework Help** - A quiet environment is provided for students to get their homework underway while a helping hand encourages if questions arise.

**Jewelry Making** - Students will learn to be creative and create bracelets, necklaces and earrings through various techniques. **Material Fee \$5.00**

**Legos Exploration**- By using their imagination and working individually and as a team students will create different structures each week.

**Lexia**: research-proven program provides explicit, systematic, personalized learning in the six areas of reading instruction, targeting skill gaps as they emerge, and providing teachers with the data and student-specific resources they need for individual or small-group instruction.

**Math Games Grades**- Students will have fun with math games that will be based and created using the district Terc math program

**Nutrition Club** – this club will teach students easy and fun nutritional value of food. Students will create projects like Healthy cookbooks. There will also some easy preparing/tasting of raw fruits and veggies.

**Painting and Drawing**-Various techniques and styles will be taught as students create a specific piece each week. **Material Fee: \$5.00**

**Read-Aloud Illustrations** - Students will listen to stories and learn to illustrate pictures by learning about reading strategies

**Stitching and Sewing** - Students are taught how to thread a needle, various stitches and to create handmade items. They choose what they want to make, and take it home to keep when they are done. **Material fee: \$10.00**

**Technology**- Students will engage in various age appropriate technology based educational activities each week.  
**Yoga**: students will learn different poses to increase strength, flexibility, and coordination
