Program description:

Each day campers will experience: performing arts, visual arts, creative play, games and sports, outside activities and computer fun. As the day winds down, campers will take a break to have lunch (provided from home) and then engage in structured play and/or an organized outside activity. Planned Activities will include:

- Music/Movement Class: campers will learn songs and dances from many cultures, culminating in a camp-wide performance.
