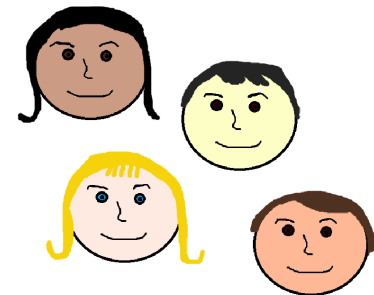

# Trinity PTA Summer Camp 2018

All Campers Kindergarten age through 5th grade that participate in the Trinity PTA Summer Camp will be exposed to a well-rounded program. Each day the camper will experience: the performing as well as visual arts, creative play, games and sports, outside activities and computer usage. At the end of the program day the campers will eat their own packed lunch and engage in structured board games and/or organized outside activity.

Campers will receive Trinity PTA Camp t-shirts, water bottles and totes. Each week the campers will wear their t-shirts on Friday for Spirit Day. Spirit Day activities will vary by the week. Campers will engage in water activities on Fridays.

In the Music/movement class campers will learn songs and dances from other cultures, (including American) and other appropriate songs throughout the five weeks. A by-product of this exploration will be a camp-wide performance.

Through the use of art projects the campers will be able to experience various media. (Paper mâché, clay, paint, etc.) In addition, some of their creations will be geared toward props and/or scenery for the camp-wide performance.

Imagination is a vital part of a child's development. Through the use of Lego building materials all campers will be able to tap into that part of them and create many varied and unusual creatures, buildings and objects.

The joy that comes from reading and being read to cannot be stressed enough. No matter the campers' age or ability books will be chosen for a read-aloud that are suitable and encompass different genres. Books that campers can read on their own for enjoyment will be available as well. Drama and other interesting activities will go along with each book chosen.

Campers will be given an opportunity to use computers with programs that foster creativity.

Summer is about fun and what better way is there to experience that than through Games and Sports. The campers will partake in games, some familiar and some not. This will broaden their experiences by learning new games that have new rules and the importance of being part of a team.
