
CHEMISTRY SCHOLARSHIP FOR ENTERING FRESHMAN

1. Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist qualified high school graduates in beginning their chemistry studies at the University of Wyoming (UW).

2. Nature

The scholarship will consist of an award of up to the equivalent of full resident tuition for the freshman year. In the event a student already has a tuition scholarship to the UW, a cash award may be made, the exact amount to be fixed by the awards committee, after consideration of the student's financial need.

3. Eligibility

Application for the scholarship is limited to high school seniors whose educational aims are to pursue a bachelor's degree program in Biochemistry, Chemistry, or in Chemical Engineering at the University of Wyoming. Students need not be Wyoming residents. The award for the spring semester is contingent upon satisfactory grades for the fall semester and continuation as a Biochemistry, Chemistry, or Chemical Engineering major at the University of Wyoming.

4. Application

The following information should be provided:

- a. Cover letter from the applicant.
- b. High school transcripts, including senior year grades for the fall semester and a listing of courses to be completed in the spring.
- c. Any other pertinent information, like results of CEEB, SAT, ACT, etc.
- d. Please arrange to have at least two letters of recommendation from the student's high school teachers sent directly to the email or physical address above.

All application materials need to be sent the Awards Chair by **February 1st, 2019**.

5. Selection

The Awards Committee will consider all complete applications received before the deadline and make recommendations for the recipient and alternates to the Executive Committee of the Wyoming Section A.C.S. After receiving authorization from the Executive Committee (normally by April 1) the Chairman of the Awards Committee will notify the U.W. Scholarship office of our selections and will cooperate with the Scholarship office for the final authorization of the award. If no worthy applicant is available or if insufficient funds are available, the committee may recommend that no award be given.

6. Announcement

The name of the actual recipient of the award will be announced at the Spring Banquet of the Wyoming Section of ACS typically sometime in April.

Clifford C. Hach Memorial Scholarship

from the University of Wyoming Chemistry Department

For students planning to enter UW in Fall, 2019, all application materials must be received by February 1st, 2019. Recipients will be notified in February (include a mailing address, and a valid email address if email notification is desired).

The scholarship honors the memory of Clifford C. Hach, who, together with his wife Kathryn Hach, founded the Hach Company in 1946. The company is headquartered in Loveland, Colorado. As a leading manufacturer of water analysis products, the Hach Company produces instruments, labware, and reagents used to monitor and test water in municipal water supplies as well as in a myriad of other industrial and agricultural applications.

The recipient of the scholarship will retain the scholarship for four years, provided he or she maintains at least a 3.0 GPA, begins as and remains a chemistry major, and makes satisfactory progress towards his or her chemistry degree. The value of the scholarship is \$6,000 per year, and is in *addition* to other scholarships.

1. Two letters of recommendation that attest to the applicant's academic potential as a chemistry major.
2. A high school transcript.
3. ACT and/or SAT scores.
4. A one page statement of the applicant's career goals.

Hach Scientific Foundation Chemistry Teacher Scholarship through the University of Wyoming Department of Chemistry

For students planning to enter UW in Fall, 2019, all application materials must be *received* by February 1st 2019. Recipients will be notified in February (include a mailing address, and include a valid email address if email notification is desired).

To support chemistry in the classroom, the Hach Scientific Foundation is working with the University of Wyoming to offer scholarships to students who will be focusing on chemistry and who agree to pursue a state-certified teaching career. Applicants must have at least a 3.0 high school GPA. Applicants must also enter into one of the UW College of Education secondary science options that provides state certification to teach high school chemistry. Applicants may also pursue dual majors in the UW Chemistry Department (B. A. or B. S. in chemistry) and the UW College of Education (secondary science teaching education).

The recipient of the scholarship will receive \$6,000 per year for five years of undergraduate study, provided he or she maintains at least a 3.0 GPA, remains an education major with a focus on chemistry, and continues to make good progress on his/her degree. Specific details of the scholarship will be provided at the time of the award.

1. Two letters of recommendation that attest to the applicant's academic potential as a high school chemistry teacher.
2. A high school transcript.
3. ACT and/or SAT scores.
4. A one page statement of the applicant's career goals.
