BUS SAFETY RULES

Listen to the bus drivers directions. He is in charge. Appropriate behavior helps the bus driver maintain attention on the road.

- Wear seatbelts.
- Remain in the seat facing the front of the bus.
- Keep hands, arms and personal belongings in the bus
- Talk quietly
- Keep the aisle clear of backpack and coats
- Cross at least 10 feet in front of the bus
- Wait for the driver's signal before crossing the street
- No eating or drinking on the bus.
- Be smart! Be safe!

1. Students are to ride only their assigned buses. **Changes will be granted upon approval by the administration. A written request to ride a bus other than the school assigned bus must be submitted in a timely fashion.**
2. Failure to follow the bus safety regulations may result in loss of school bus privileges.

First Offense – warning and parent notification

Second Offense – parent notification and loss of recess

Third Offense – assigned seating or loss of transportation privileges

Any subsequent offence may result in bus privileges being suspended.

(The bus driver at his/her discretion may request for a child to sit in an assigned seat.)
