

## Kindergarten Transition into Penn-Trafford School District!

***We would like to potentially welcome your child into Kindergarten for the 2020-2021 school year. Entering Kindergarten is an exciting time for both you and your child! Our District plans some **FUN** activities and events that will assist you and your child in the transition to Kindergarten.***

**First Stop: Kindergarten Kick Off Night on Wednesday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020.** This event takes place in each individual elementary school in the evening. More detailed information is mailed in March. Students attend this evening! Parents sign up for a screening time with the Principals, receive a 2020-21 school calendar, and visit booths from local organizations where they can meet school support staff, local community organizations, and PTO representatives. Your child will be able to meet the school Kindergarten teachers and receive a backpack with supplies. The evening will conclude with a ride on a school bus!

**Second Stop: Kindergarten Screening, June 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020.** A member of our Kindergarten staff will give your child the district Kindergarten Screening Assessment. The teacher will discuss the results with you. You will also be able to meet with the school nurse to turn in your health forms and discuss your child’s health needs for the school year.

**Third Stop: Kindergarten Open House, EITHER August 24 OR 25, 2020, (Differs by Elementary School).** You will accompany your child to school during our Open House evening for a visit and orientation with your child’s Kindergarten teacher.
