Our Language Program

French fluency program for bilingual children

- Objectives: To offer French-speaking students an opportunity to receive French instruction at the same level as they would in France. Experienced French native teachers teach the classes.
- Audience: French-speaking students of all grades, from Kindergarten to Eighth grade. Students are grouped by level.
- Programs: From Kindergarten to Fifth grade, we are following the Cours Sainte-Anne curriculum. In Sixth, Seventh and Eighth grades, we follow and enrich the CNED curriculum.
- Format: Classes meet an average of one period per day, depending on their grade. Class sizes are small, with actual class size varying from 1 to 11 in 2015.
- Annual fees apply.

French or Spanish as a second language

- Objectives: Develop cognitive abilities of children through exposure to another language. Studies show that learning a foreign language stimulates the brain, it helps use your own language more effectively, opens the mind and strengthens self esteem.
- Audience: all children in Kindergarten through Fourth grade will attend French or Spanish language classes. All Sixth, Seventh and Eighth graders attend Spanish classes as part of their curriculum.
- Programs: Kindergartners through 4th graders learn basic interpersonal communication skills, including how to introduce themselves in the target language, describe their immediate environment, express their needs and discover another culture. In Sixth, Seventh and Eighth grades, the children take a grade weighted Spanish class as part of their GPA.
- Format: Classes meet one to three times per week for one period. In Kindergarten and First grades, the students interact in the target language during the class through songs, stories, and educational games. In Third and Fourth grades, they add the written component. In the middle school levels, they move on to more advanced language studies.
