Over the summer it is necessary that we remember to schedule a specific time each day to read and review math facts with our children. This will assist students in strengthening the skills and academic gains your child made this year. In addition, all students will receive access codes to log onto reading and math computer programs (iReady, Raz Kids, MyOn, Mathletics, etc.) and a "Tech Log" to record the amount of minutes your child logged on to each site. All of our programs are accessible on computers, iPads, and cell phones. Certificates and prizes will be awarded to students for their participation. In grades K-2, students will also receive a list of sight words students should be able to read and spell with ease. All students will be responsible for handing in their "Tech Log" on the first day of school to their teacher. This "Tech Log" will count as your child's first grade for the new school year, so it is important that it is filled out everyday and handed in on time.

I wish everyone a safe and restful summer. It has been a pleasure to work collaboratively with such a passionate and hardworking community. I look forward to building on these accomplishments next year. Working together, we can accomplish great success for our students!
