Parent Options Survey (2 Options)

1. **100% Remote Learning:** Opt in to have your child learn 100% remotely (all online, from home). To choose this option for your child, fill out and submit this form. If you are having difficulties completing this form online, call 311.

2. **Combination of In-Person and Remote Learning:** Your child can follow their school's schedule, a mix of in-person days at school and remote learning days from home. To choose this option, no action is needed: your school will be in touch about its schedule and programming plans in the coming weeks. 
Changing Preferences

Parent Survey Results

Phased Return to School			
The survey asked families to rank the following options for what school could look like in the fall.	Percent who ranked this option as their first choice	Percent who ranked this option as their second choice	Percent who ranked this option as their third choice
Sending your child to in-person school on certain days like Monday, Wednesday, and Friday or Tuesday and Thursday. On the days that your child is not in school, she/he would be learning at home.	 61%	19%	5%
Having your child learn at home full-time everyday	24%	7%	38%
Sending your child to in-person school one week and then learning at home the next week.	15%	34%	15%

P.S. 103 Reopening Schedule (ABC model)

Summary:

- Three in-person cohorts, one remote.
- Provides regularity on days per week with some variation by week (e.g. Group A is in-person every Wednesday, as well as on Monday in week 1 and Tuesday in week 3).
- Because this model provides the greatest degree of regularity among the three-cohort models, it is the only option available for elementary schools and is "Chancellor Recommended" for middle schools that must program for 1/3 of their students.
- **Group A**, **Group B**, **Group C**: in-person learning 1-3 days per week (5 days every 3 weeks); remote learning for non-in person days.
- **Group D**: remote every day; consists of students who opt out of in-person instruction.

P.S. 103 Reopening Plan

- Group A, B, C schedules will be determined after we receive the final number of families that choose to opt-in to 100% remote learning.
- **Class Sizes:** 9-13 children per class on each given day
- Limited movement throughout the building
- During remote learning days, students **MUST** log into google classroom, review videos posted, and complete assigned work before next in-class session.

P.S. 103 Reopening Plan (continued)



- Due to the hybrid model, students are expected to use the provided devices at home and at school.
- Initially, all students must bring their devices to school to ensure proper set-up for the school year.
- More information to follow.

P.S. 103 Reopening Plan (continued)

- Administration, Custodial Staff, and Nurses Office are working together to develop the arrival and dismissal procedures that will ensure the safety for all staff and students based on the CDC guidelines.
- Based on strict guidelines, all students must be picked up promptly at dismissal. Late pick up will no longer be allowed in the school building due to safety measures.
- Once we get our plan approved by the District and get the final numbers from the survey, we will meet again with families to discuss the details.
