Core Instruction - Reading, Writing, Word Study, & Mathematics, with some Social Studies & Science integration - whole-class and small group opportunities

Other' Instruction refers to small group Reading, ENL (English as a New Language) SPED (Special Education) and Related Services (such as Speech, OT, PT) and Counseling. Teacher who specialize in these fields will join classroom meetings and/or meet with students separately

Asynchronous - Work completed independently offline or w/caregiver support. Teachers post work for students to complete independently.

CAMPEL - refers to separate special classes (Computer Science, Art, Music, Physical Education, and Library). All students will have one live (synchronous) CAMPEL each day!, including Art, Music, Physical Education, Library, and Foreign Languages (FLES)

SEL (Social & Emotional Learning) and Social Justice Learning are collaborative and interrelated activities aimed at nurturing positive classroom environments, supporting students' pride and sense of worth, encouraging honest self-reflection and assessment, honoring the multiple group identities and our school community's rich cultural, racial, and ethnic diversity. Classroom teachers will lead meetings and engage students in discussion and other activities primarily during morning and afternoon meetings.
