Dear Parents and/or Guardians,

It has come to the District's attention that an inappropriate comment made earlier in the week by one of our High School students created an inaccurate rumor of a threat of violence that circulated throughout the school community. **The Nassau County Police Department conducted a thorough investigation and determined that there was no credible threat. At no time was student safety compromised, and at no point was the school day interrupted.** In addition, appropriate action was taken with respect to the student who made the inappropriate comment.

Always remember that the safety of our students, faculty and staff is the highest priority at the Uniondale School District. When the rumor was brought to the District's attention, District officials took immediate action and notified law enforcement to look into the situation. We take these rumors seriously, and we always err on the side of caution.

We consider it our duty to keep parents, students and staff informed. I encourage you to call your building principal or me if you have any questions about our safety procedures and protocols.
