**Space is limited, there will be ONE CAR permitted on school grounds for each graduate.**

**If you do not have a vehicle, the graduate and parents can enter through the Walnut Street gate at 2:30 PM on your scheduled date to receive their high school diploma.**

- Everyone in the graduate's car must wear a face mask (CDC: Health and Safety Rule).
- All cars will line up on Walnut Street alongside Uniondale High School's Baseball Field.
- All cars will enter through the Walnut Street Entrance
- Staff members will direct you during the Car-mencement ceremony.
- Upon entrance into the school grounds, please make sure your son/daughter's full name is on a sheet of paper and placed on the dashboard of your car. This will be used to identify the distribution of your high school diploma.
- An index card with your first, last name will be utilized to announce your name, as you walk across the stage. Please bring a pen to write your home address on the reverse side of the index card. The information will be used to send your graduation picture to your home.
- During the processional, you should maintain proper social distancing. When you arrive at the stage, your child will pick up a diploma cover and walk across the stage as his/her name is being announced.
- When you walk across the stage, a photo will be taken by a professional photographer. You will proceed and receive your high school diploma. Afterwards, you and your family will exit the school grounds through the Goodrich Street gate.


**This is a celebration, please remember to decorate your cars for this festive Car-mencement ceremony.**
