A six week structured research internship where students will be matched with a Baruch College faculty member. Students must complete and pass the spring course to participate.

Primary Requirements:

- Be a NYC Public H.S. junior with overall 80+ average,
- 75+ ELA Regents OR 480+ PSAT/SAT Verbal/Critical Thinking,
- 80+ on any Math Regents Exam, and
- 75+ on any Science Regents Exam

Although the STEM Research Academy is primarily designed for 11th graders, 10th graders with the following grades will be considered:

- An overall 80+ average,
- Overall 80+ English average,
- 80+ Math average, , and
- 80+ Science average
