Mile club for November is the 16th

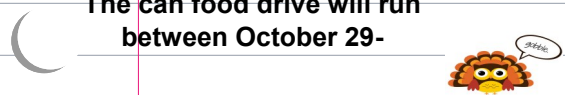
The Coaches sent a memo in the beginning of the school year regarding homework.
