Enjoy summer in NYC with our fun-filled and educational camp for kids, ages 6-14.

The Manhattan College Summer Day Camp offers a truly unique experience, combining the vast resources of a higher education institution with learning-based activities that will keep children engaged all day. Campers will have access to Manhattan College resources such as classrooms, computer labs, and our five-story library. The camp will take place on campus at our convenient New York City location. **The program runs from Monday, June 25 to Friday, August 17; 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.**

Our priority is education and safety. The program combines fun with learning as kids participate in activities designed to help them develop new skills, try out new hobbies and make long-lasting friendships. Children will expand their creativity through art, math, and reading activities, as well as learning a number of important skills using computers and in science. Our educational activities are taught by Manhattan College's top education students, who have teaching experience with children at different school levels. CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

ARTS

Children will be familiarized with arts activities. Children will create several projects and channel their creativity into different types of art forms.

SCIENCE

Children will be introduced to the basic topics of science through activities and hands-on experiments. Our science class will develop the child's scientific knowledge and point of view.

READING/MOVIE

Our reading and movie class is designed to build on the child's critical and reading skills. Children will also watch film adaptations to correlate what they have read and analyzed.

COMPUTER

Children will expand their skills in computer software and applications that will help them in the future. Through interactive and exciting projects, this fun activity will help increase children's relationship to modern technology.

MATH

Our math class will expose children to several math activities to understand related math concepts. children will strengthen their reasoning and problem-solving skills through fun math problems.
